ORDER

In a Memorandum Opinion and Order dated and filed on May 30, 2014, Circuit Judge Ambro, acting pursuant to Rule 25(f), Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, dismissed the complaint in the above matter.

Complainant filed a petition for review by the Judicial Council of the Third Circuit on June 16, 2014.

The Judicial Council has considered the petition for review and has concluded that the relief requested should be denied and the order of Judge Ambro should be affirmed for the reasons set forth in his Memorandum Opinion.
