This Court has inherent authority to exercise control over the access to its workplaces in order to avoid interruptions to the performance of the duties of the Court and its employees. The libraries of the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit were established and are maintained solely for the purpose of supporting the judicial mission of the federal courts within the circuit. Members of the bar, government attorneys, members of government agencies, and other members of the public may use the libraries for the purpose of conducting legal research subject to library rules on access, services and conduct.

Upon consideration whereof, it is Ordered that the Policy on Access, Services and Conduct dated March 8, 2013, is hereby approved and adopted to be effective July 11, 2013 or as soon thereafter as convenient. The Circuit Librarian is directed to effectuate the policy in all branches of the Library.
