**ORDER**

As the parties have already been notified, oral argument will take place on Wednesday, February 11, 2004 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The Court will convene at 9:30 a.m. The Court has decided that it will allocate the oral argument times as follows:

The parties and intervenors belonging to the Deregulatory Petitioners and Anti-Deregulatory Petitioners groups are hereby directed to confer among their group and to further allocate the total argument time for each group. The parties shall advise the Clerk in writing no later than January 28, 2004 which attorneys will be arguing, the specific issues to be addressed by each attorney, and the number of minutes allocated to each attorney.
