ORDER

In a Memorandum Opinion and Order dated and filed on May 8, 2017, Chief Judge Smith dismissed the complaint in the above matter and the request to present evidence was denied.

Complainant filed a petition for review by the Judicial Council of the Third Circuit on May 24, 2017, including a request to “attend and personally present evidence.”

The Judicial Council has considered the petition for review and has concluded that the relief requested should be denied and the order of Chief Judge Smith should be affirmed for the reasons set forth in his Memorandum Opinion.

Pursuant to Rule 19, Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, it is therefore ORDERED that the May 8, 2017 order of Chief Judge Smith is AFFIRMED. Petitioner's request to present evidence is denied.

The parties are notified that this order is final and conclusive and is not judicially reviewable on appeal or otherwise. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(c).
