ORDER

In a Memorandum Opinion and Order dated and filed on September 1, 2022, Chief Judge Chagares dismissed the complaint in the above matter.

Complainant filed a petition for review by the Judicial Council of the Third Circuit on October 7, 2022, and an amended petition for review on October 25, 2022.

The Judicial Council has considered the submissions and has concluded that the relief requested should be denied and the order of Chief Judge Chagares should be affirmed for the reasons set forth in his Memorandum Opinion.

Pursuant to Rule 19, Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, it is therefore ORDERED that the September 1, 2022 order of Chief Judge Chagares is AFFIRMED.
