ORDER

In a Memorandum Opinion and Order dated and filed on September 8, 2022, Chief Judge Chagares dismissed the complaint in the above matter.

Complainant filed a petition for review by the Judicial Council of the Third Circuit on November 16, 2022.

The Judicial Council has considered the petition for review and has concluded that the relief requested should be denied and the order of Chief Judge Chagares should be affirmed for the reasons set forth in his Memorandum Opinion.
