ORDER

In a Memorandum Opinion and Order dated and filed on July 9, 2024,
Chief Judge Chagares dismissed the complaint in the above matter.

Complainant filed a petition for review by the Judicial Council of the Third
Circuit on July 30, 2024.

¹ The Judicial Council is acting pursuant to Rule 25(g) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings (authorizing the Judicial Council to vote that it is “necessary, appropriate, and in the interest of sound judicial administration that one or more subject judges be eligible to act . . .”).

The Judicial Council has considered the petition for review and has concluded that the relief requested should be denied and the order of Chief Judge Chagares should be affirmed for the reasons set forth in his Memorandum Opinion.

Pursuant to Rule 19, Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, it is therefore ORDERED that the July 9, 2024, order of Chief Judge Chagares is AFFIRMED.

The parties are notified that this order is final and conclusive and is not judicially reviewable on appeal or otherwise. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(c).
