In a Memorandum Opinion and Order dated and filed on May 30, 2025, Chief Judge Chagares dismissed the complaint in the above matter. Complainant filed a petition for review by the Judicial Council of the Third Circuit on June 17, 2025 and a supplement to the petition for review on June 25, 2025.

The Judicial Council has considered the petition for review and has concluded that the relief requested should be denied and the order of Chief Judge Chagares should be affirmed for the reasons set forth in his Memorandum Opinion. Pursuant to Rule 19, Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, it is therefore ORDERED that the May 30, 2025, order of Chief Judge Chagares is AFFIRMED.
