ORDER

In a Memorandum Opinion and Order dated and filed on November 12, 2025, Chief Judge Chagares dismissed the complaint in the above matter.

Complainant filed a petition for review by the Judicial Council of the Third Circuit on January 5, 2026.

The Judicial Council has considered the petition for review and has concluded that the relief requested should be denied and the order of Chief Judge Chagares should be affirmed for the reasons set forth in his Memorandum Opinion.

Pursuant to Rule 19, Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings, it is therefore ORDERED that the November 12, 2025 order of Chief Judge Chagares is AFFIRMED.
