DISTRICT COURT OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS

ORDER

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 332(d)(1), and

WHEREAS, Chief Judge Robert A. Molloy of the District Court for the District of the Virgin Islands currently maintains his duty station in the Division of St. Thomas and St. John; and

WHEREAS, Chief Judge Molloy has expressed a desire to relocate his duty station to the Division of St. Croix; and

WHEREAS, the District Court of the Virgin Islands is a two-district judge court that should maintain a district judge presence in each of its divisions; and

WHEREAS, the District Court of the Virgin Islands currently has a judicial vacancy,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that effective August 1, 2025, Chief Judge Molloy shall be permitted to relocate his duty station to the Division of St. Croix, and he shall continue to maintain a presence and preside over cases in the Division of St. Thomas and St. John until such time as a new district judge is appointed to the District Court of the Virgin Islands and seated with a duty station in the Division of St. Thomas and St. John.
